



INTERVIEW RUTH RAHLFF



What prompted you to write a children's book about artificial intelligence?

Most of all, I wanted to attempt the impossible: to unite the worlds of AI and the supernatural. But during my research and writing, I came to the conclusion that there are indeed similarities between the two worlds: wild and surprising events that appear to come out of the blue ...

Which aspect of AI do you find the most exciting - and which the most horrifying?

The most exciting: how advanced the technology behind AI has become. The most horrifying: how advanced the technology behind AI has become.

Why does the book take place in a world where there are ghosts?

At the center of the story is Robert, a boy who's trying to make his way in two completely opposite worlds. And there's a little nostalgia in that: among a modern cityscape of skyscrapers, new housing developments and drab apartment blocks, there aren't that many places that ghosts can haunt to their hearts' content. It's high time we give them a stage again!

What do you personally find really spooky?

I still can't walk alone across a cemetery at night... And I think it's eerie when I've been talking to someone on my smartphone and then afterwards, I suddenly discover keywords on subjects discussed in the conversation.

Can you tell us what the third volume of the series will be about?

In the next book Robert finds out just how dangerous a pet store can be; also, Medusa makes an unexpected decision that has far-reaching consequences.





Things are as turbulent as ever, and something unprecedented occurs: guests arrive at the island, who stay for several days and who are not complete strangers to some in the school.



Milk Without Honey it is not only a comic. It's also a non-fiction book, chock-full of "hard facts." How did you manage to translate these facts into a – in our opinion – poetic pictorial language?

It was precisely this connection between verse and science that I wanted to portray – without relying on clichés. The pictures show what the text cannot express, and vice versa. The focus is on the insects; humans are only visible through their actions and the consequences of those actions. This guiding principle was a crucial help to me in coming up with the illustrations.

Did you also reach the limits of illustration? Did it sometimes get too "busy"?

In a comic, there is a relatively high amount of content on few pages, so that the subject doesn't appear overwhelming. The continuous narrative of text and image facilitates the representation of complex processes and interrelationships. The most trouble I had was in limiting the informative content; after all, the bee is the most well-researched insect there is. To make the crawly chaos more abstract, my main strategies were the use of metaphors, a limited color palette, and a grid template.

How long were you involved with the subject and the work on the book?

Milk Without Honey began in 2019 as my degree thesis.

Several years ago I read something about how closely interwoven the cultural history of mankind and the history of bees are. As the news reports on the worldwide die-off of bees became more numerous, I kept thinking more and more about this paradox of people practically worshipping bees while at the same time willfully destroying their habitat.

For the publication, I went back and expanded the book.

Are you already working on a new graphic book?

I'm planning a graphic series about the effects of human actions on the environment, with Milk Without Honey as the first volume.

The second volume will be about the significance of forestlands and their dying off. Unfortunately, there are many subjects to write about.
